The Lackawanna Susquehanna County Early Intervention Program provides services and supports designed to help families with children who have developmental delays. Early Intervention builds upon the natural learning opportunities that exist in a child's typical routines within the home and community. The Early Intervention process promotes collaboration among parents, service providers, and others significantly involved with your child. Early Intervention can enhance your child's development by:

- Answering your questions
- Enhancing your capacity to meet the developmental needs of your child
- Enhancing your child's developmental and educational growth
- Supporting your child with developmental delays to become more independent
- Supporting families with accessing services to address developmental and behavioral issues.

If you have any questions about your child's ability to:

- Speak or understand language
- Play like other children his/her age
- Sit, crawl, or walk
- Suck from a bottle, chew, or swallow
- Use his/her hands and fingers to play or eat
- See or hear
- Tolerate sounds, light, or touch

Or if your child:

- Has a diagnosis
- Was premature (less than approx. 3lbs. at birth)
- Is a victim of abuse or neglect
- Was born with a chemical dependency
- Has been exposed to lead
